- What? Health Leaders Call for National Mobilization Opposing Cuts to Programs that Support America's Women, Children and Families on October 26
- Who? AMCHP, WIC, National Family Planning and Reproductive Health Association, and **US!!**
- Why? In the next few weeks, Congress will be considering additional cuts to critical discretionary health programs for women, children and families that could exceed \$1 billion in 2012 alone. Elected officials need to hear a clear message that these cuts are unacceptable.

Share this simple message: you oppose any efforts cut core programs for women, children and families, including Title V, WIC and Title X

Other key points to share include:

Women and children should not be at the forefront of any discussion to reduce the federal deficit. We urge you oppose any efforts to cut core programs for women, children and families, including **Title V** and instead take a balanced approach that does not start with cuts to programs for women and children.

These programs provide the foundation for efforts to improve the health of women and children in our state. Further cuts will devastate state and local programs serving pregnant women, babies, children and children with special health care needs.
